

Date 1 Feb. 2016. Black Sugarloaf, Birralee (big tree track).

Habitat: Closed wet Eucalypt forest.

Substrate: Standing dead small eucalypt.

Description: two groups (37 & 3) of gregarious short stalked sporangia to 1.1 mm high. **Sporangia** sub-cylindrical to ovate, rounded at apex and base, 0.8 mm long, dark brown.

Hypothallus contiguous under groups, membranous, shiny.

Peridium fugacious. **Stalk** black, grooved, wider where it attaches to substrate, 0.3 mm. **Columella** reaches to near apex of columella where it branches, translucent red by transmitted light. **Capillitium** sparse, attached at right angles along length of columella; dark near columella, lighter at tips. **Spores** dark brown in mass, lighter brown in transmitted light, warted with patches of darker warts, 11–12 μ m.

Notes Spores too large for *C. anomala*. (Poulain *et al.* #516).
