

Date 28 June 2016. Black Sugarloaf (big tree track downslope from Bedfordia hill). **Habitat:** Closed wet Eucalypt forest.

Substrate: twig fallen among fronds of *Dicksonia antarctica*.

Description: small group of dark brown stalked sporangia 1–1.7 mm high. **Sporotheca** subglobose to ovoid, 0.6 high x 0.5 mm wide. **Stalk** black, shiny, slightly flared at base, about half the length of sporangia; reddish brown and fibrous at base by transmitted light. **Peridium** fugacious except for apex and base of sporotheca. **Columella** reaches to the apex of sporotheca, gradually tapering upwards with membranous expansion at apex. **Capillitium** attached along full length of columella, brown, lighter at tips; warts, small rods and wrinkles at tips. **Spores** brown with sinuous reticulate pattern, 6.5–7.5 μm .

Notes: Keys out to *C. subalpina* Poulain *et al.* (2011) except membranous expansion at apex of columella is not mentioned. Also collected from ground litter, June 2014 (MEL# 320).
