

**Date** 8 Oct. 2013. Black Sugarloaf, Birralee (big tree track).

**Habitat:** Closed wet Eucalypt forest.

**Substrate** decaying wood.

**Description** scattered stalked sporangia, 0.9 mm high.

**Sporotheca** globose, yellow, 0.15 mm diameter. **Stalk** red and yellow, 0.4–0.5 mm long. **Hypothallus** inconspicuous.

**Peridial net** fugacious leaving small membranous calyculus and angular meshes without conspicuous nodes and no free ends. **Spores** yellow in mass, colourless by transmitted light, minutely spiny (warted?), 7  $\mu$ m.

**Notes** One collection only, but this is a very small species that is likely to be overlooked in the field.
