Didymum bahiense Gottsb.

Date 25 April 2012. Black Sugarloaf, Birralee (home). Habitat: Eucalypt forest: vegetable garden. Substrate stem of *Foeniculum vulgare* (fennel). Description scattered to gregarious stalked sporangia, 1.2 mm high. Sporotheca subglobose, 0.4–0.6 mm diameter. Stalk slender, subulate, yellowish brown, darker at base grading to lighter at apex. Hypothallus discoid or contiguous under adjacent sporangia, yellowish brown. Peridium white crystalline lime, dehiscence irregular. Columella absent but large pseudocolumella discoid, white. Capillitium delicate hyaline threads attached to pseudocolumella and peridium; hyaline to light brown by transmitted light Spores dark brown in mass, brown by transmitted light, coarsely warted with clusters of warts, 10 μm. Notes: One collection only.
