Date 9 Nov. 2013. Black Sugarloaf, Birralee (home: up track) **Habitat**: Eucalypt forest. **Substrate**: Bark of dying Eucalypt. **Description**: Scattered and grouped stalked pyriform sporangia, 2 mm high. Sporotheca pyriform, 1 mm x 0.7 mm diameter, brown, darker at base, dehiscence petaloid or circumscissile leaving ragged edge. Hypothallus discoid or contiguous under group, brown like extension of stalk. Peridium not aerolate; patterning (visible with oil immersion lens) overlain with amorphous particles. **Stalk** longitudinally furrowed, shiny, reddish brown, darker at base, 1 mm long x 0.3 mm wide. **Capillitium** yellow in mass, yellow brown by transmitted light with spiny spiral bands, 5 µm diameter; some free ends have long spinule. Spores: Yellow in mass, yellow brown by transmitted light, warted,  $7.5-9.5 \mu m$ . **Notes**: One collection only.
