Date 20 Nov. 2016. Black Sugarloaf, Birralee (big tree track).

Habitat: Closed wet Eucalypt forest.

Substrate decayed *Pomaderris apetala* on the ground. **Description** several clusters of crowded stalked fuscous brown sporangia 6–9 mm high. **Sporotheca** cylindrical, erect and drooping, fuscous brown, 0.4 mm diameter. **Stalk** back, shiny, < ½ height of sporangia. **Hypothallus** contiguous under group, membranous, colourless. **Peridium** fugacious. **Columella** reaches to almost the apex of sporotheca.

Capillitium arises from full length of columella, 2–3 meshes between columella and periphery, membranous expansions; surface net of thin threads with small angular meshes. **Spores** brown in mass, reticulate, $7.5–9 \mu m$.

Notes: common species at Black Sugarloaf.
