

Black Sugarloaf, Birrale (Big tree track near *Cyathea* corner)

Habitat: Closed wet Eucalypt forest.

Substrate: Soil, dead roots, moss and leaves on ground.

Description: Sessile plasmodiocarps and sporangia, bright red at first, dark red when mature, terete 0.3 mm wide.

Peridium: Brittle, dark red with yellow lime.

Capillitium: Yellow lime nodes and colourless flattened tubules.

Spores: Dark brown in mass, brown by transmitted light, 7–8 μm minutely warted.

Notes: three collections:

6 Dec 2014, on soil roots and leaves (0267)

11 Jan 2015, decayed wood on ground (0301)

21 Feb 2015, Standing dead *Bedfordia salicina* (0376)
