

Date 28 June 2016. Black Sugarloaf, Birrale (big tree track).

Habitat: Closed wet Eucalypt forest.

Substrate Leaning dead eucalypt near large *Banksia marginata*.

Description scattered stalked sporangia 0.5–1.9 mm tall.

Sporotheca globose, pinkish brown, 0.2–0.3 mm diameter.

Stalk subulate, black; brown and fibrous at base by

transmitted light. **Hypothallus** inconspicuous **Peridium**

membranous, fugacious **Columella** reaches to approximately

$\frac{1}{3}$ of sporotheca where it divides in two. **Capillitium**

branches several times before periphery; free ends at periphery

with some swellings, brown, 1–2 μm diameter. **Spores** mid

brown in mass, light brown by transmitted light, minutely

warted, 7.5 μm .
